




## The AEA German Cultural Committee **Presents:**

## Traditional German





In this fun program students will learn how people in Germany traditionally prepare for the Easter Holiday. Students will be introduced to new German vocabulary and have plenty opportunities to practice conversing in German.



The class will start **Monday March 1**st (from 2:50-4:20) and will have four sessions:

Session 1 (March 1st): **Easter crafting** 

Students will craft a variety of traditional Easter decorations.

Session 2 (March 8<sup>th</sup>): Easter baking

Students will bake and eat! traditional Easter pastries.

Session 3 (March 15<sup>th</sup>): Easter egg painting

Older students will blow out eggs and then paint them. The younger students will work on less fragile (boiled and/or artificial) eggs. Several of the decorated eggs will be used for the "Osterbrunnen" decoration.

Session 4 (March 22<sup>nd</sup> ): Crafting decorations for the "Osterbrunnen"

Students will work on garlands and flower decorations for the Easter Well.

As participant of this class you are invited to join us for a special family event on Sunday, March 28th at the House of Germany in Balboa Park. We will be decorating the Easter Well together and then go on an Easter Egg Hunt!
